AXA Achievement & Community Scholarship: AXA Achievers are ambitious, set and reach goals, have respect for self, family and community and the ability to succeed in college. Download an application for a \$2,000 college scholarship at www.axa-achievement.com

AFA Teens for Alzheimer's Awareness College Scholarship: This scholarship is for college-bound students who are coping with Alzheimer's disease in their families, or for other teens volunteering in their communities. Students must submit an essay. The grand-prize winner will receive \$5,000, the first runner-up will receive \$500 and the second runner-up will receive \$250. GE-Reagan Foundation Scholarship Program: This scholarship annually awards roughly 20 college-bound students who demonstrate exemplary leadership, drive, integrity, and citizenship with \$10,000 renewable scholarships – up to \$40,000 total per recipient. Community Action Council Outstanding Community Service Award: This was established to recognize graduating high school seniors for service to their communities. Selection of the recipients will be based upon their individual, voluntary contributions to improving the social and economic conditions in their community. Each recipient of the Award will be given a plaque recognizing his/her contributions and a cash award of \$100, \$500 or \$1000. Only one student from Lexington Catholic may be nominated. Applications are in the guidance office.

Kentucky Farm Bureau Education Foundation Scholarship Program: The KY Farm Bureau Education Foundation will award 66 county and state scholarships for the current school year. Scholarships can be applied to tuition, housing, books, etc. of a four year course of study. To be eligible, applicants must have either a minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA or a minimum 23 ACT score and be a child of a Kentucky Farm Bureau member and remain such while the scholarship is in force. Fergus Hanson Memorial Scholarship: Named in honor of Fergus Hanson, Lexington Clinic's second and longest-serving administrator, the Fergus Hanson Memorial Scholarship fund provides scholarships in allied health sciences to Central and Eastern Kentucky students. Applicants must be a resident of Kentucky and reside within Central or Eastern Kentucky, earn a high school diploma or equivalent, show evidence of financial need, show promise of academic achievement, select a career in a health-related field other than dentistry or veterinary medicine, studying at an accredited program, plan to work in Central or Eastern Kentucky upon graduation, and provide evidence of good character and willingness to help others. 2012 Ripple Effect Scholarship Program: Kentucky American Water launched its Ripple Effect Scholarship Program in 2002 with a focus on academic excellence and community service. The program focuses specifically on recognizing high school seniors' commitment to one of the key areas of corporate responsibility – environmental stewardship.
